TODAY - Week #1: Attention God-ward: Deepening our connection with God Himself (praying, loving, serving). Teacher: Judith Hylton.


Week #2: Attention Inward: Being willing to reveal our true selves (listening, welcoming, sharing). Teacher: Pastor Ray Hylton.


